Noticeably her paintings vibrates with an intensity of colour which edges of lines are blurred with emotion. Through the exploration of gestures and obscurity of colours, Rosenbäck hopes to evoke a strong emotional response. Her aim is to create a feeling of contemplation and transcendence beyond the canvas.
