Camille Joy Johnston graduated from the university of Michigan with honours in Art History and Global Media Studies in 2007, she has also gained a high class honours Masters in Art Business from Sotheby's Institute. Johnston started her career as the artist in residence for Gabrielle Shaw Communications before becoming a freelance photographer. Within her work, the artist blurs the boundaries between photography and text by mixing kitsch ideas with modern art philosophy. Her illustrative and photographic collection displays the dynamic of these boundaries through contrasting images and literal definitions. Light hearted humour is translated into her artwork as the artist aims to bestow viewers with an essence of a "mischievous giggle" within her compositions.
